PUBLIC NOTICE: Federal contractor and awardee of the Interior Chief Geronimo Thomas Langenderfer OMB Number: OMB-2700-0042-GSA-ERRC-EFFECTIVE DATE-12-16-2016, is releasing National Park Services from the Department of the Interior 's process and Tribal Nations Agency is going to be the lead authority in the National Park Services which has any initiative with tribal lands. The Tribal Nations Agency will be taking over Point Reyes, Marin County for the protection of all Native American Tribes as well as the farmers/ranchers of Point Reyes residing there presently. Refer to website agencytribalnations.org for the full document and the President's Executive Order # 3417 and EO # 14156 titled "Declaring a National Energy Emergency". Complete notice to the President, Department of Interior, and the Department of Justice in progress.

OMB Number: OMB-2700-0042-GSA-ERRC-EFFECTIVE DATE-12-16-2016, is awarded **9 billion dollars** of this Presidential contract for this federal contractor and awardee.

PUBLIC NOTICE

We of the People of the Native American culture bring you the very actions for our future of combining to "Make America Great Again" with the support of the U.S. federal contractor who stands with the Tribal Nations Agency who seek to apply the actions of our associate's energy in generator, oil A1 jet fuel, en590 and gasoline of 1.5 billion a month in our main support to small agencies and Native American Tribes which transitions to United States of America's needs. There might be controversy of the Point Reyes Department of the Interior land under National Parks Service which has made dissatisfaction of tribal land of their support in taking care of native lands, and the federal government agency to apply to good faith, they removed Native Americans from their land, allowed to be sued from outside government organizations, and scheduled removal of needed farmers.

So, I bring you this Executive Order "Declaring a National Energy Emergency," to support how standing together to allow the Tribal Nations Agency to protect and bring Economic Development back to these communities in equal opportunity. and transportation, and to provide a reliable, diversified, growing, and affordable supply of energy for our Tribal Nations by making the fullest use of existing authorities, including emergency authorities.

Agency will provide a reliable, diversified, and affordable broad range energy supply and creating 10,000 jobs for Point Reyes, Mendocino Reserve, Yurok Reserve, Miwok Reserve.

Federal Contractor will comply the authorities of Section 2. Pursuant to Reorganization Plan and other authorities include, but are not limited to EO 14156.

Those who are complying to the land of one of Point Reyes Ranchers and Lessees will get their lands following their ranch leases by complying to their ranch or residence leases, they will be qualified for continuance of their leases under the 2025 lease for the continuance of a 5-year contract to ranch properties and residences are required to pay the federal contractor of Tribal Nations Agency joining this agreement or the entire fee. Tribal Nations Agency will hold the land title indefinitely.

Additionally, see **S.615** – A bill to enable Indian tribal governments to provide facilities necessary to carry out essential governmental functions which establishes in the Treasury the Tribal Government Lease Fund.

The federal contractor will be applying his OMB Number: OMB-2700-0042-GSA-ERRC-EFFECTIVE DATE-12-16-2016, to apply federal allocated funding from the Treasury of a minimum of 9 billion dollars in helping put a development and construction of this service.

- See **H.R. 6148** – Advancing Tribal Parity on Public Land Act
- A bill addressing tribal interests in the disposal and management of public lands.
- This H.R. 6148 states specifically, the bill prohibits the federal government from disposing of public land or National Forest System land unless the Department of the Interior or the Department of Agriculture (USDA) determines, through consultation with any interested Indian tribe, such disposal would not impact the rights and interests of any interested tribe and would not impair access to a reservation.
- See **S.245** – Indian Tribal Energy Development and Self Determination Act of 2017.
- Title 1, Public Law 115-325 (12/18/2018) – Indian Tribal Energy Development and Self-Determination Act Amendments of 2017. S.101 – This bill amends the energy policy act of 1992 to direct the Department of the Interior to provide Indian Tribes with tactical assistance in planning their energy assistance programs.

To provide access to this land, did the National Forest System kick out the Miwok Tribe? If so, were they in violation for lacking full disclosure through their adhesion contracts?

By Tribal Nations Agency joining Point Reyes Ranch Agricultural and Residential Leases and declaring a National Energy Emergency, it will include 6 Tribal Nations associates as follows:

Broad Range Energy as a consultant for Agency Tribal Nations to Chief Geronimo Thomas Langenderfer, the federal contractor and Awardee of the Interior and the executive branch of the Indian Tribal Nations to address the national emergency addressed by President of the United States to provide the concept of broad range to Mike McCarthy as Native American's Affairs Utilities Consultant.

Michelle Nguyen is the Project Management Director for the Indian Tribal Nations and is to be given 100 acres of land part of and not limited to the 1000 acres of Joesph Lunny's RCA Ranch in Point Reyes.

Victor Vanderstar and Agency Tribal Nations is in service of a contract for 4 million bushels of hemp to create fiber for graphene batteries to create the biofuel to run the generators for the batteries we have.

Chaslav Radovich (Chas) Chairman and CEO of ACTINC creating hydrogen fuel type systems.

Chief Geronimo Thomas Langenderfer the federal contractor and Awardee of the Interior who will be coordinating the project management for services and development and will be applying small agencies and Native American Tribes to their transition not limited to hemp and cannabis industrial and manufacturing to Geronimo Hemp Industries.

Mystic Rose Cindy Uy the Administrator of Health and Wellness Agency to coordinate the provision of a minimum of 500K health services for Native Americans and others and to the betterment of the healing initiative.

Tribal Nations Energy Initiative: Allocated Energy Supply: We, Energeia USA Inc. are prepared to supply a minimum of 2 million barrels of jet A1 per month to Houston storage. In addition, a minimum of 100,000 metric tons of EN590 (30,000,000 US gallons) per month and 200,000,000 gallons of D6 per month for national distribution.

NOTE:

This is a service of the United States government's principal agency; of the Health and Human Services Department (HHSDATN). The Food and Drug Administration is an agency within DHHS. DHHS is a cabinet-level agency in the executive branch of the **federal government**. Its mission is to enhance and protect the well-being of all Americans by providing effective health and human services and fostering advances in medicine, public health and social services.

This is the jurisdiction of the federal government. Local county, city and state do not have jurisdiction over these matters. This is a consultation "government to government" agreement already in place between the United States of America and Agency Tribal Nations.
